Parent/Guardian Agreement and Responsibilities

- Registration forms and payments are due by **Friday, April 1st, 2016** and can be returned via Info Flo or dropped off at the office in person. Payments are accepted as cash or checks made out to "VSAS."
- Registration is confirmed at the time of payment on a first come-first served basis.
- Courses may be canceled if the minimum enrollment is not met by the registration deadline.
- VSAS will make every effort to accommodate course preferences. In cases of course cancellation and if no other accommodation is possible, VSAS will refund payments in 5-10 business days after the start of the program.
- No refunds will be made after the first week of classes.
- All students not enrolled in A+ should gather at the multi-purpose room after the end of regular school classes to be picked up by their after-school instructor or coordinator. Students will be walked to their after-school classroom or transported to the Middle School campus for sports as a group. Students can be picked up by parents/guardians/guardians directly from the class location at the end of a class. Students who are not picked up by parents/guardians will be returned to the multi-purpose room at the end of class where parents/guardians can collect them.
- Students enrolled in A+ should go to A+ program and check in. They will be collected directly from A+ by an after-school instructor or coordinator. All A+ kids will be returned to A+, unless picked up by a parent/guardian from the class location.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for picking up students on time after the end of classes. If you want your child to walk or bike home, please make sure to complete all necessary school documentation and let the instructor know that your child will be walking or biking home after class. The instructors are responsible for students in their care and may not leave until all students have been picked up, so please be prompt. A late fee of \$5 per 15 minutes will be due upon arrival.
- Students who engage in unsafe behaviors or who are repeatedly disruptive to class will be given a warning and parents will be contacted. If the behavior continues, the student may be dismissed from the class.
- Assumption of Risk and Release form is required for all students enrolled in athletic courses.
- VSAS is committed to providing enrichment opportunities to all students. Limited scholarships are available. Use the registration form to request your scholarship.
 - ✦ Courses are **open to all children and youth** in Volcano and neighboring communities. Students do not have to be enrolled at VSAS to participate.
